

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF RICHFIELD WITH RESPECT TO PAYMENT OF FUNDS BY THE TOWNSHIP FOR SENIOR CITIZENS RECREATION PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Village and the Trustees of the Township of Richfield desire to enter into a contract with respect to participation in and payment for Senior Citizens Recreational Programs.

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Township of Richfield with respect to Senior Citizens Recreational Program and for payment for such programming.

Section 2: The form of the contract, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, is approved.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to take advantage of the summer months and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by Law.

AGREEMENT

Whereas the Village of Richfield (The Village) intends to provide and maintain a recreational program (The Program) for senior citizens, and

Whereas the Village and the Township of Richfield (The Township) desire to enter into an agreement with respect to participation by Township senior citizens, and

Whereas the Township desires to pay on behalf of senior citizens resident within the Township the actual cost of participation.

Now therefore the Village and the Township agree as follows:

1. The Village, so long as it maintains a program for senior citizens, shall allow participation in the program by senior citizens resident within the Township.

2. The Township shall on behalf of those citizens pay the actual cost of their participation, such payments to be made to the Village in six-month intervals, the first of which shall be December 31, 1984.

3. Actual cost shall be the total cost of the program divided by the number of Village and Township residents who participated in the program times the number of Township residents who participated in the program.

4. The Director of Finance shall, in sufficient time for the Township to timely pay the actual cost, provide a full and complete accounting of the participation in the program and the amount to be paid by the Township.

5. This Agreement shall end at the earliest of the following dates (a) The date on which the Village discontinues the program (b) 30 days after notice by the Village of intent to discontinue the program or 30 days after notice by the Township to discontinue participation (c) by mutual consent.

6. The agreement is made pursuant to Village Ordinance 41-1984 and Township Resolution _____.
