

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RICHFIELD TOWNSHIP WITH RESPECT TO THE AVAILABILITY FOR USE BY TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS OF THE SENIOR CITIZENS VAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield intends to provide bus transportation to Senior Citizens who are local residents pursuant to Ordinance 34-1984, and

WHEREAS, the Trustees of Richfield Township desire to have available the bus for the use of Senior Citizens who are resident within the Township, and

WHEREAS, the Township of Richfield desires to pay to the Village part of the cost of such transportation for the use of residents of Richfield Township.

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Township of Richfield providing for the use of the bus and payment therefor.

Section 2: The terms and conditions of the contract, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, are approved.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety for the reason to provide transportation and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.

AGREEMENT

Whereas the Village of Richfield (The Village) intends to provide and maintain bus transportation facilities (the facility) for use by local senior citizens, and

Whereas the Village and the Township of Richfield (The Township) desire to enter into an agreement with respect to participation by Township senior citizens, and

Whereas the Township desires to pay on behalf of senior citizens resident within the Township the actual cost of their participation.

Now therefore the Village and the Township agree as follows:

1. The Village, so long as it maintains the facility for local senior citizens, shall allow participation in the facility by senior citizens resident within the Township.

2. The Township shall on behalf of those citizens pay the actual cost of their participation, such payments to be made to the Village in six-month intervals, the first of which shall be December 31, 1984.

3. Actual cost shall be the total cost of the facility divided by the number of Village and Township residents who used in the facility times the number of Township residents who used in the facility.

4. The Director of Finance shall, in sufficient time for the Township to timely pay the actual cost, provide a full and complete accounting of the use in the program and the amount to be paid by the Township.

5. This Agreement shall end at the earliest of the following dates (a) The date on which the Village discontinues the use of the facility (b) 30 days after notice by the Village of intent to discontinue the facility or 30 days after notice by the Township to discontinue participation (c) by mutual consent.

6. The agreement is made pursuant to Village Ordinance 42-1984 and Township Resolution _____.
