

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CLERK OF COUNCIL TO ACCEPT EMPLOYMENT AS SECRETARY OF THE PARK AND RECREATION BOARD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 4.06 of the Charter of this Village provides that the Clerk of Council shall not be otherwise employed by the Municipality and shall hold no other public office except as provided by the Charter or ordinance and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of this Village intends to appoint Mary Higley as Secretary of the Park and Recreation Board and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to provide authority in this ordinance form for Mary Higley to occupy the employment position of Clerk of Council and Secretary of the Park and Recreation Board.

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: That Mary Higley may upon appropriate appointment by the Mayor be otherwise employed by this municipality as Secretary of the Park and Recreation Board and may serve as such secretary in addition to serving as Clerk of this Council.

Section 2: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide permission by ordinance, and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
