

AN ORDINANCE TO SET YEARS OF SERVICE FOR LONGEVITY AND ANNUAL LEAVE FOR HILDEGARD GUERIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Council fixes, effective on October 15, 1984, that the years of service for longevity and for annual leave shall be six years for Hildegard Guerin.

Section 2: Council authorizes and directs the Mayor and Director of Finance to pay such longevity compensation and to authorize such annual leave as are in accordance with Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide pay and allowances and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
