

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT AND TO MAKE PAYMENTS THEREUNDER TO THE CITY OF AKRON FOR MUNICIPAL COURT PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

- Section 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the City of Akron with respect to costs of the Municipal Court of Akron.
- Section 2: The Village of Richfield is within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipal Court of Akron.
- Section 3: The form of the contract, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, is approved and the Director of Finance is authorized to draw on and pay from the proper account of this Village such sum or sums as proper to complete the terms of the contract.
- Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to comply with State Law on the subject of courts and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
