

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE 42-1982 TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR MASONRY WORK AND CONCRETE FOR A FIRE TOWER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Village desires to provide masonry work and concrete for the construction of the Fire Tower set forth in Ordinance 42-1982, and

WHEREAS, the cost thereof should be paid by the Village.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Section 3 of Ordinance 42-1982 is amended to read as follows:

Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and Directed to accept on the part of the Village the completed fire tower and are further authorized and directed to pay to Automatic Sprinkler Corporation, as the cost of such masonry work and concrete the sum of \$4,999.00

Section 2: Existing Section 3 of Ordinance 42-1982 is hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide for extra foundation work for fire testing facilities and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
