

AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT SECTION 333.021 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES WITH RESPECT TO RECKLESS OPERATION OF VEHICLES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio:

Section 1: Section 333.021 of the Codified Ordinances is enacted to read as follows:
333.021 RECKLESS OPERATION ON STREETS, PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY.

- (a) No person shall operate a vehicle on any street or highway without due regard for the safety of persons or property.
- (b) No person shall operate a vehicle on any public or private property other than streets or highways, without due regard for the safety of persons or property.

This subsection does not apply to the competitive operation of vehicles on public or private property when the owner of such property knowingly permits such operation thereon.

Section 2: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide against reckless operation of motor vehicles and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
