

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MUNICIPAL ENGINEER TO PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR RESURFACING BRECKSVILLE ROAD, A DISTANCE OF 2.6 MILES, MORE OR LESS, FROM A POINT AT THE ENTRANCE TO INTERSTATE 271 TO THE ENTRANCE TO INTERSTATE 77 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

- Section 1: The Municipal Engineer is authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications at a cost not to exceed \$5,000 for the resurfacing of Brecksville Road, a distance of 2.6 miles, more or less, from a point at the entrance to Interstate Route 271 to a point at the entrance to Interstate Route 77.
- Section 2: The Municipal Engineer is further directed to complete such specifications and plans and deliver the specifications and plans to the Director of Public Service, no later than June 7, 1983.
- Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason of an urgent need to commence with the resurfacing work and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
