

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE FRONT STREET FROM STREETSBORO ROAD, NORTH A DISTANCE OF 167 FEET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of Front Street within the Village of Richfield have petitioned this Council to vacate said street and

Whereas, the petitions were duly referred to the Planning and Zoning Commission for report and recommendation, and the recommendation is in support of the vacation of Front Street for a distance of 167 feet and

Whereas, abutting owners have waived notice of the intention to vacate Front Street by the filing of a written consent with this Council and

Whereas, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause for vacating Front Street a distance of 167 Feet and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the public interest.

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The portion of Front Street beginning at the entrance of the intersection of Front Street and West Streetsboro Road and extending therefrom northerly a distance of 167 feet is hereby vacated.

Section 2: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason that park development funds are available and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
