

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 78-1979 WITH RESPECT TO A LIBRARY COMMITTEE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Last Will and Testament of Isabelle LeVerne Chase, deceased, provides a gift for certain library purposes and Item II of such Last Will and Testament provides for the appointment of five persons, resident of Richfield for no less than ten (10) years to carry out those purposes, and

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Ordinance 78-1979 is amended to read as follows:

Section 1: The following appointments to the Committee for library purposes as set forth in the Last Will and Testament of Isabelle LeVerne Chase, deceased, are hereby made and confirmed.

- Richard Wagner

- Carol Merrick

Section 2: The appointees shall, as soon as is reasonably possible, meet and take action necessary and appropriate under and pursuant to the terms of such Will together with any other orders, judgments or decrees of the Probate Court of Summit County, Ohio.

Section 2: Ordinance 78-1979, in so far as this Ordinance 34-1983 amends, modifies or otherwise makes changes therein, is repealed. All other sections or parts of Ordinance 78-1979 which are not amended or changed by this Ordinance 34-1983 are not repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason of time to have a complete membership and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
