

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO SELL ONE (1) REFUSE PACKER.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has found that personal property, being one refuse packer, is not needed for municipal purposes,

WHEREAS, the estimated value of one refuse packer is in excess of ~~Five~~ <sup>Four</sup> Thousand Dollars (\$~~5~~<sup>4</sup>,000.00), and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that the property is not needed for municipal purposes and should be sold,

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for the sale of one refuse packer not needed for municipal purposes.

Section 2: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder after advertising in accordance with R. C. 721.15.

Section 3: The proceeds of the sale shall be accepted by the Director of Finance and deposited to the appropriate account of the Village of Richfield.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
