

ORDINANCE NO. 43 -2013

Offered by All of Council

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE VILLAGE SURPLUS PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO SELL SAID PROPERTY BY AUCTION AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR AUCTIONEER SERVICES

WHEREAS, this Council has reviewed the list of personal property attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and has determined that said property is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired, and, thus, is surplus property; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to sell said surplus property by public auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor and Finance Director to engage Edward J. Pfister III for auctioneer services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the personal property of the Village of Richfield listed in "Exhibit A" attached hereto is hereby declared as being no longer needed for public use, obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired.

SECTION 2. That said personal property listed in "Exhibit A" hereto be sold by public auction.


SECTION 3. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Edward J. Pfister III for auctioneer services for said personal property on substantially the same terms as the contract attached hereto as "Exhibit B."

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

3. I (or we) agree to pay you a commission of 10 percent of the gross proceeds of such sale. The City of Richfield shall pay for the following expenses _____
