

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF FUELS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village

of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1:

That the Director of Public Service is authorized to advertise for bids for the purchase of fuels in accordance with the specifications now on file with the Director of Public Service.

Section 2:

The specifications for the fuels referred to in Section 1 are hereby approved.

Section 3:

The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement for the purchase of such fuels with the lowest and best bidder after advertising according to law.

Section 4:

This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason fuels are urgently needed for municipal services and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
