

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE FURNISHING OF EXTENDED AREA TELEPHONE SERVICE (EAS) BETWEEN THE 659 EXCHANGE OF WESTERN RESERVE TELEPHONE COMPANY AND THE 666 EXCHANGE OF GENERAL TELEPHONE COMPANY OF OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the Village of Richfield and the Township of Bath are contiguous and,

Whereas, there are many people in Richfield and Bath who although they live in one area use shopping, medical, dental, insurance and many other forms of service which are located in the other area and,

Whereas, there are residents of Bath who have Western Reserve Service and residents of Richfield who have General Telephone Service and,

Whereas, the telephone service between these areas require the placing of and payment for a long distance call and,

Whereas, there is a community of interest between these two areas which demands and supports extended area service: (EAS) in one or more of its various forms.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Council finds and determines there is an unsatisfied general need for EAS between the Village of Richfield and the Township of Bath.

Section 2: Council supports any effort by subscribers to the service of Western Reserve Telephone Company and General Telephone Company of Ohio to implement EAS between the involved exchange areas.

Section 3: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason a present need exists for EAS and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.


