

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF 1,000 TONS OF SALT, MORE OR LESS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the purchase of 1,000 tons of salt, more or less, for road purposes.

Section 2: The specifications for such salt, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, are hereby approved.

Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the lowest and best bidder for such salt after advertising according to law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason the salt is needed for the winter season and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
