

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH AARON COMPANY FOR TRASH COLLECTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 24-1982 authorized the Director of Public Service to advertise for bids for trash collection service and

WHEREAS, Aaron Company is determined to be the lowest and best bidder for such service;

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1:

The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to on behalf of this Village enter into an agreement for trash collection with Aaron Company.

Section 2:

The form of the contract now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service is hereby approved.

Section 3:

The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to draw on the appropriate account of the Village for the payment for such service, after being satisfied of the correctness of the amount therefore.

Section 4:

This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide for trash collection service and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.

AGREEMENT

Pursuant to Ordinance ~~2~~7-1982 of the Village of Richfield, Ohio, the Village (Village) and Aaron Company, A Partnership, (Contractor) agree as follows:

1. The Contractor will collect, transport, and dispose of garbage, refuse, and rubbish and heavy trash on Tuesdays and Wednesday of each week for the period of this Agreement.

2. The Contractor will observe and conduct its operation according to the following schedule on the following streets and highways:

(a) On TUESDAYS

- (i) North of Route 303
- (ii) Hawkins
- (iii) Southern
- (iv) Sunset
- (v) Overdale
- (vi) Roberts
- (vii) South side of Route 303 West of Broadview Road

(b) On WEDNESDAYS

- (i) South of Route 303 and all other Village Roads.

(c) HOLIDAYS

The collection shall be on the day before the holiday.

(d) On State Highways one side only will be serviced at the same time in order to avoid workmen crossing the roadway.

(e) Collection shall begin between the hours of 7:30 and 8:00 a.m.

3. The Contractor will perform the service in a sanitary and satisfactory method. The specifications and proposals of the Contractor are incorporated herein and the duties set forth therein shall be the duties of the Contractor.

4. The Contractor will bill the Village on a monthly basis. The billing shall be a representation that the billing is based on actual service performed in accordance with the specifications and proposal.

5. The village shall pay the Contractor the sum of \$38,890.00 as an annual fee for such service. Payments shall be made on the 15th day following the billing under the provisions of Paragraph 4.

6. The duties under this Agreement shall begin on the 8th day of November, 1982, and shall end on the 7th day of November, 1983.

7. The Contractor shall not have the right to commence service until it shall have filed with the Director of Public Service the Certificates of Insurance and Workmen's Compensation set forth in the specifications.
