

A RESOLUTION TO THE OWNERS OF CERTAIN LANDS TO DRAIN LOTS AND REMOVE SUBSTANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, certain property owned by Hugh and Anna Henry, Raymond and Helen Glenn, Richard and Deborah Pace, and Francis G. and Florence Cappuccio within the Village of Richfield contains stagnate waters, and

WHEREAS, the stagnate waters are prejudicial to the health, comfort, and safety of the citizens of the neighborhood, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield has power to abate nuisances and require payment therefore under the provisions of the Ohio Constitution and R.C. 715.47.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1:

The Council of the Village of Richfield directs Hugh and Anna Henry, Raymond and Helen Glenn, Richard and Deborah Pace, and Francis G. and Florence Cappuccio to drain such lots and remove such putrid substances and if necessary enlarge culverts in order to create a situation necessary to the health, comfort, and safety of the citizens of the neighborhood.

Section 2:

The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to serve a certified copy of this Resolution upon the owners set forth herein.

Section 3:

The owners shall comply with the terms of this Resolution within fourteen (14) days from the effective date of this Resolution.

Section 4:

In the case of failure or refusal to comply with the terms of this Resolution the Village will perform as its expense and such expense shall be recovered from each separate owner in accordance with the actual cost attributed to each owner.

Section 5:

The expense therefore from the time of the Resolution shall be a lien ^{on} the land of such owners.


Section 6:


This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason
