

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ACCEPT A GIFT OF A FIRE TRAINING TOWER FROM FIGGIE INTERNATIONAL, AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER CORPORATION, A DIVISION. *440 declaring an emergency*

WHEREAS, The Automatic Sprinkler Corporation of America, a Division of Figgie International, proposes to donate labor and materials to this Village for the purpose of building a test facility to be known as a fire tower, and

WHEREAS, such a training facility would be in the best interest of this Village and would strengthen and promote training for the personnel of the division of fire and at no cost to this Village.

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The proposed gift of labor and materials for the construction of a fire tower shall be accepted by this Village.

Section 2: The specifications for the construction and design and for the construction thereof shall be approved by the Director of Public Service and the Fire Chief.

Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to accept on the part of the Village the completed Fire Tower.

Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to promote fire safety by proper training and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
