

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) MOWING TRACTOR WITH TRADE-IN AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER.

Be It Resolved by the Council for the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Council finds as follows:

- (a) The Village owns a mowing tractor which is not fit for public use.
- (b) A need for one (1) other such tractor of the same type.
- (c) The best interest of the Village will be served by a simultaneous sale thereof with the purchase of new tractor.

Section 2: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the purchase of One (1) mowing tractor and to sell the presently owned equipment.

Section 3: The specifications for the purchase and sale as referred to in Section 1 hereof now on file in the Office of the Director of Public Service are approved.

Section 4: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a single contract for the sale of such equipment and the purchase of new equipment with the lowest and best bidder after advertising according to law under the provisions of Section 721.25 Revised Code.

Section 5: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
