

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) MOTOR VEHICLES WITH TRADE-IN AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Council finds as follows:

- (a) The Village owns motor vehicle equipment which is not fit for public use by the Division of Police.
- (b) A need for two (2) other motor vehicles of the same type;
- (c) The best interest of the Village will be served by a simultaneous sale thereof with the purchase of new vehicles.

Section 2: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the purchase of two (2) motor vehicles and to sell the presently owned equipment.

Section 3: The specifications for the purchase and sale referred to in Section 1 hereof, for the use of the Division of Police now on file in the Office of the Director of Public Service are approved.

Section 4: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a single contract for the sale of such motor vehicle equipment and the purchase of motor vehicles with the lowest and best bidder after advertising according to law under the provisions of Section 721.15 Revised Code.

Section 5: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason of the need to have safe vehicles and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
