

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A SETTLEMENT WITH THE FRATERAL ORDER OF POLICE, OHIO LABOR COUNCIL, LODGE 66; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended that Council authorize the attached settlement agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Lodge 66 to resolve the pending grievance filed Patrol Officer William Sprit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. The Mayor and Director of Finance are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Settlement Agreement Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Lodge 66 substantially in accordance to the terms and conditions of the attached draft agreement subject to final approval from the Director of Law.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary pay out the agreed upon settlement; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
