


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BPI OHIO FOR THE PURCHASE AND REPLACEMENT OF 2 SERVERS AND 1 SAN (STORAGE AREA NETWORK) SERVER, USER LICENSE, AND SERVER LICENSE THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM (CONTRACT CTR # 006819), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to purchase two servers, one storage area network server, a user license, and a server license from BPI Ohio through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program (Contract # CTR006819) for a total purchase price of \$57,883.00 to replace its current equipment that is at the end of support.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:


- SECTION 1. The Mayor and Finance Director are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with BPI Information Systems 6055 West Snowville Rd., Brecksville, Ohio 44141 through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program to purchase two servers, one storage area network server, a user license, and a service license for a price not to exceed \$57,883.00 with such contract subject to final approval from the Director of Law.
- SECTION 2. Because this purchase is made under the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program, Council waives the requirement for competitive bidding pursuant to Section 141.03(f) of the Richfield Codified Ordinances.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that it is immediately necessary to purchase and upgrade the Village's servers and corresponding licenses to ensure the Village's computer network continues to operate in an efficient manner; wherefore, this Resolution shall take immediate effect, provided that it receives the requisite number of votes needed to pass as an emergency measure; otherwise, it shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
