

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING VILLAGE COUNCIL'S APPROVAL AND SUPPORT FOR THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR FUNDING RELATED TO THE KINROSS LAKES PARKWAY SOUTH ROAD EXTENSION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Summit County Transportation Improvement District offers competitive funding opportunities for public transportation improvement projects in Summit County ; and

WHEREAS, the Kinross Lakes Parkway South Road Extension Project is a significant public project that will improve transportation within the Village and the County; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to pass this Resolution of support of grant funding from the Transportation Improvement District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:


- SECTION 1. Council hereby approves and supports the submittal of an application to the Summit County Transportation Improvement District for the Kinross Lakes Parkway South Road Extension Project.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village and for the further reason that this resolution is needed in order for the Village administration to promptly apply for the grant funds as soon as possible; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council it shall take immediate effect upon signature by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
