

RESOLUTION NO. 3 -2013

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE NEW SERVICE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT FROM BAKER VEHICLE SYSTEMS THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO PURCHASING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield is a member of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to contract to purchase new equipment for the Service Department from Baker Vehicle Systems, under the State Purchasing Program, and wishes to trade in equipment that is no longer of useful service to the Village and apply the proceeds to the purchase of the new equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase the following new equipment for the Service Department, under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program, from Baker Vehicle Systems, in a total amount not to exceed \$7,708.00 after application of trade-in credits.

1. Two (2) new Hustler Super Z Zero Turn Mowers
2. Two (2) new Flex Forks
3. One (1) new Smithco Aer-8 60" Aerifier
4. One (1) new 60" Roller
5. One (1) new Transport Frame Assembly
6. One (1) new Hydro Hose Kit

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and Finance Director are authorized and directed to trade in the following equipment, which is hereby declared surplus municipal property that is no longer of useful service to the Village, for not less than \$21,352.00 in credit and to apply the credit to the purchase of the new equipment authorized under Section 1 above.

1. One (1) 2005 Jacobsen Mower
2. One (1) Grass Hopper Mower
3. One (1) Cushman Aerator

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
