

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO SOLICIT PROPOSALS FOR THE GLENCAIRN FOREST BASIN RESTORATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village desires to maintain and repair certain sewer lines and infrastructure located Glencairn Forest; and

WHEREAS, the basin in which said lines and infrastructure are constructed is in need maintenance or repairs; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee has recommended that this Council authorize the Mayor and Director of Public Service to solicit proposals from qualified professionals as to how the Glencairn Forest basin can be restored or stabilized in order to best protect the integrity of the sewer system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Director of Public Service are hereby authorized and directed to solicit proposals from qualified professionals as to how the Glencairn Forest Basin can be restored or stabilized in order to best protect the integrity of the sewer system.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to protect the integrity of the sewer system; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
