

A RESOLUTION DECLARING VARIOUS ITEMS OF VILLAGE PERSONAL PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO SELL SAID PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, R.C. 721.15 authorizes Council to adopt a Resolution authorizing the sale by Internet auction of personal property that is no longer needed for public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, Council adopted Resolution No. 1-2022 authorizing the sale, by Internet auction, of surplus Village personal property which is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired and authorized the Mayor to select a representative to conduct such Internet auctions; and

WHEREAS, Council has received a recommendation from the Mayor and the Fire Chief that 2,500 feet of large diameter hose manufactured by Mercedes is longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired and thus is surplus property that should be disposed of via Internet auction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. This Council finds that the 2,500 feet of large diameter hose manufactured by Mercedes is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired, and, thus is surplus property that should be discarded and/or made available for disposition by Internet auction and that an Internet auction shall be conducted by GovDeals.com.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of ensuring that the Village can expeditiously discard and/or dispose of the surplus property via Internet auction; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law
