

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. FOR THE REPAIRS AND CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE VILLAGE FOR THE 2022 SEASON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council passed Resolution 20-2022 and Resolution 21-2022 on April 5, 2022 authorizing the Director of Public Service to advertise and solicit bids for certain repairs and construction of sidewalks for the 2022 season in accordance with the specifications prepared by the Village Engineer; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service recommends acceptance of the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., in the amount of \$291,256.00, which consists of the base bid of \$218,382.00 for the Broadview Road sidewalk extension project from Emerald Blvd. to Giant Eagle; the alternate no. 1 bid in the amount of \$40,000.00 for miscellaneous sidewalk repairs, and alternate no. 2 bid in the amount of \$32,874.00 for the Humphrey and Streetsboro ADA crossing project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. Council accepts the base bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., located at 525 Dan Street, Akron, Ohio 44310, for \$291,382.00 for the above identified sidewalk repair and construction projects.
- SECTION 2. Council authorizes the Mayor and Finance Director to execute all necessary contracts with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., in accordance with the company's bid, and to add a 10% contingency amount to the contract subject to final approval from the Director of Law.
- SECTION 3. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to authorize the 2022 Asphalt Road Repaving Program; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor;

otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
