

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. FOR THE 2023 ASPHALT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service advertised and solicited bids for the 2023 Asphalt Program in accordance with the specifications prepared by the Village Engineer; and


WHEREAS, bids were received for the 2023 Asphalt Program and opened on May 16, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Village Engineer recommend acceptance of the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., in the amount of \$ 950,166.00, plus an additional \$266,181.80 (\$166,875.20 for Townsend Road and \$ 99,306.60 for Gianni Way), as being the lowest and best bid for the 2023 Asphalt Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. Council accepts the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., located at 525 Dan Street, Akron, Ohio 44310, for \$950,166.00 plus an additional \$266,181.80 (\$166,875.20 for Townsend Road and \$ 99,306.60 for Gianni Way) for the 2023 Asphalt Program.
- SECTION 2. Council authorizes the Mayor and Finance Director to execute contracts with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. in accordance with each company's respective bid, and to add a 10% contingency amount to each respective contract.
- SECTION 3. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to authorize the 2023 Asphalt Road Repaving Program; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Village will be receiving funds from State of Ohio and Summit County Engineer for road paving.
State of Ohio \$380,000.00 for paving Streetsboro Road & Broadview Road.
Summit County \$180,000.00 From Permissive License Tax Fund.
Developers will be funded for road repair on Gianni Way. Working on what that amount:
