

A RESOLUTION FORMALLY REQUESTING A PERMIT FROM THE OHIO TURNPIKE INFRASTRUCTURE COMMISSION TO REPLACE APPROXIMATELY 230 LINEAR FEET OF DAMAGED MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER SANITARY SEWER FORCE MAIN LOCATED ON REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE OHIO TURNPIKE INFRASTRUCTURE COMMISSION (4960 BRECKSVILLE ROAD, PPN 50-00682) IN THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Village to replace approximately 230 linear feet of damaged municipal wastewater sanitary sewer force main located on real property owned by the Ohio Turnpike Infrastructure Commission (4960 Brecksville Road, PPN 50-00682), and that prior to the commencement of any replacement activity, it is mandatory that the Village of Richfield formally request a permit for said construction in accordance with the Resolutions of the Ohio Turnpike Commission, a copy of the Village's permit application is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, passage of a Resolution formally requesting a permit is a prerequisite to obtaining a permit and receiving a draft contractual agreement which will impose certain obligations and restriction on the Village's activities on the real property owned by the Ohio Turnpike Infrastructure Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, Village of Richfield shall pay the costs and expenses of the work to be performed under the proposed request, and said Village of Richfield will be responsible for all related costs of construction including inspection and future maintenance of this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to secure a permit from the Ohio Turnpike Commission to replace approximately 230 linear feet of damaged municipal wastewater sanitary sewer force main located on real property owned by the Ohio Turnpike Infrastructure Commission (4960 Brecksville Road, PPN 50-00682).

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield and that the within action is necessary for the immediate repairs to the municipal sewer system and to ensure there are no delays in the replacement project, and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected or


appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.

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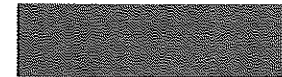
