

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 147.06 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO INCREASE THE FEES FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Administration has reviewed the fees for emergency medical services and has recommended that Council increase the fees as set forth below.

WHEREAS, Council finds and determines that the increase in emergency medical service fees is in the best interests of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit; State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. That Section 147.06 of the Codified Ordinances is amended as follows:

**“FEE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.**

(a) The following fee, per person, per call, for services rendered by the Village of Richfield to individuals transported to a medical facility shall be as follows:

(1) Emergency Transport (Basic Life Support) ~~\$550.00~~ **\$850.00.**

(2) Advanced Emergency Transport (Advanced Life Support (ALS) & ~~ALS2~~) ~~\$600.00~~ **\$1,000.00.**

(3) **Advanced Emergency Transport (Advanced Life Support 2 (ALS2) \$1,200.00.**

(4) Mileage at ~~\$10.00~~ **\$16.00** per loaded mile.

(5) **Non-Transport \$300.00.**

\*\*\*”

SECTION 2. That Section 147.06 of the Codified Ordinances in effect prior to the passage of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason

that it is immediately necessary to bill for services rendered at the newer rates; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
