

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 145.10, "AGE FOR POLICE OFFICERS", PERTAINING TO AGE REQUIREMENTS FOR ORIGINAL APPOINTMENTS OF POLICE OFFICERS

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield (the "Village") wishes to amend the age restriction for initial appointments of police officers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio, that:

Section 1: Section 145.10, "Age for Police Officers" of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to hereinafter provide as follows:

"145.10 AGE FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

No person shall be eligible to receive an original full-time appointment to the Police Department unless the person has reached the age of twenty-one. ~~Further, no person shall be eligible to receive an original full-time appointment in the Police Department when the person is thirty five years of age or order."~~

Section 2: That any ordinance in conflict with Section 1 of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Council finds and determines that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date permitted by law.
