

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO RE-ADVERTISE AND SOLICIT BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ONE COLUMBARIUM AND RELATED SITE WORK AT FAIRVIEW CEMETERY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 44-2023, Council authorized the Director of Public Service to advertise and solicit bids for the installation of three (3) columbaria and related site work at Fairview Cemetery;

WHEREAS, after review of the bids submitted, the Village did not award the contract;

WHEREAS, the Council desires to authorize the Director of Public Service to re-advertise and solicit bids for the installation of one columbarium and related site work at Fairview Cemetery in a manner consistent with the recommendations of the Richfield Cemetery Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to advertise and solicit bids for the installation of one (1) columbarium and related site work at Fairview Cemetery in a manner consistent with the recommendations of the Richfield Cemetery Board.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to timely complete the installation of the columbarium and related site work; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
