

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 717, "TEMPORARY STORES," FROM THE BUSINESS REGULATION CODE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Chapter 717 of the Codified Ordinances currently regulates "Temporary Stores" in the Village;

WHEREAS, Chapter 717 was enacted in 1967, prior to the Village's enactment of a comprehensive planning and zoning code;

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Code regulates the operation of temporary stores in the Village;

WHEREAS, the Council desires to repeal Chapter 717 of the Codified Ordinances to ensure that there is no conflict between what is permitted or prohibited by the Planning and Zoning Code and Chapter 717.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:


SECTION 1. That Chapter 717 of the Codified Ordinances, "Temporary Stores," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. That any ordinance or resolution in conflict with Section 1 is repealed.


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that it is immediately necessary to eliminate any ambiguity with respect to the Village's regulation of temporary stores; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take immediate effect, provided it receives the requisite number of votes needed to pass as an emergency measure; otherwise, it shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.


