

A RESOLUTION DECLARING FIRE TRUCK ENGINE 13 AND MISCELLANEOUS PERSONAL PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO SELL THE VEHICLE AND MISCELLANEOUS PERSONAL PROPERTY BY PUBLIC AUCTION, INTERNET AUCTION, OR ANY OTHER LAWFUL MEANS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, R.C. 721.15 allows for this Council to adopt a Resolution authorizing the sale of personal property, including motor vehicles, and other personal property and equipment referenced in the statute, which is no longer needed for public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was required, by public auction, internet auction, or other lawful means; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to sell certain surplus property via public action, internet auction, or other lawful means; and

WHEREAS, this Council has received a recommendation from the Fire Chief that the following Fire Department vehicle is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired, and, thus, is surplus property and should be disposed of at public auction, internet auction, or any other lawful means:

WHEREAS, this Council has received a recommendation from the Fire Chief that miscellaneous personal property exists as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, which is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired, and, thus, is surplus property and should be disposed of at public auction, internet auction, or any other lawful means.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the following Fire Department vehicle is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired, and, thus, is surplus property and available for disposition by public auction, internet auction, or any other lawful means:

SECTION 2. That miscellaneous personal property exists as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, that is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired, and, thus, is surplus property and should be disposed of at public auction, internet auction, or any other lawful means.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to facilitate the auction of this service department vehicle at the earliest possible time in order to maximize the value recoverable by the public entity; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


