

A RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION AND GRATITUDE TO OLESIA'S TAVERNE OF RICHFIELD

WHEREAS, The Village commends Olesia's Taverne of Richfield for going above and beyond to design a first-class establishment; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council particularly appreciate Olesia's Taverne of Richfield's commitment to the center of Richfield.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, SUMMIT COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1. The Council and administration formally wish to recognize and further extend its appreciation to Olesia Pochynok and the staff of Olesia's Taverne of Richfield for being a significant part of Richfield's Historic District.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to recognize Olesia Pochynok and her commitment to the Village. Therefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately


upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


