

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 623 TYPE 1 ALUMINUM BODY CONVERSION, MOUNTED ON A 2018 FREIGHTLINER M-2 CHASSIS EMERGENCY MEDICAL VEHICLE FROM HORTON EMERGENCY VEHICLES COMPANY, PURSUANT TO THE STATE OF OHIO TERM CONTRACT SCHEDULE, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services, through the Office of Procurement Services, provides political subdivisions with the opportunity to do business with certain manufacturers through a State Term Schedule ("STS") contract under which the State will enter into a contract for goods or services with a manufacturer at the same prices that the manufacturer offers to distributors for those goods and services or, if the manufacturer has no distributors, the prices that the manufacturer offers to its similarly-situated most favored customers; and

WHEREAS, political subdivisions who wish to purchase from a STS supplier are required to obtain a minimum of three quotes from various STS suppliers offering similar or like items; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield, as a political subdivision of the State of Ohio, may acquire goods under the STS at the contractor's best pricing; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to contract to purchase one (1) 623 Type 1 aluminum body conversion, mounted on a 2018 Freightliner M-2 Chassis emergency medical vehicle, from Horton Emergency Vehicles Company, 3800 McDowell Road, Grove City, Ohio 43123, under State of Ohio term contract schedule 800330 for the amount of Two Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Four Dollars (\$252,844.00) as set forth in the proposal attached hereto as "Exhibit A;" and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief and a committee from the fire department developed and distributed specifications to three (3) ambulance builders that participate in the STS program: PL Custom; Horton Emergency Vehicle Company; and Braun Corporation; and

WHEREAS, after distributing specifications and visiting the two Ohio-based companies, Horton Emergency Vehicle Company and Braun Corporation, the committee selected Horton Emergency Vehicle Company as the best quality and best price; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Richfield Codified Ordinance Section 141.03, Richfield Village council may waive competitive bidding requirements if the purchase is made pursuant to a State of Ohio cooperative purchasing program under R.C. 125.04 or 5513.01; and

WHEREAS, this purchase was approved as a part of the 2017 capital items budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase a Horton 623 Type 1 aluminum body conversion, mounted on a 2018 Freightliner M-2 Chassis emergency medical vehicle, from Horton Emergency Vehicles Company, 3800 McDowell Road, Grove City, Ohio 43123, under State of Ohio term contract schedule 800330, for the amount of Two Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Four Dollars (\$252,844.00), as set forth in the proposal attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated fully herein by reference.

SECTION 2. That because this purchase is made under the State of Ohio term schedule contract program, this Council waives the requirement for competitive bidding pursuant to Section 141.03(f) of the Richfield Codified Ordinances.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to facilitate the acquisition of a new emergency medical vehicle at the earliest possible time, given that it takes four weeks from the date the contract is signed to schedule the pre-build meeting and seven and one-half months from that date to delivery, and given the need to replace an emergency medical vehicle currently in use; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

CONTRACT EXPLANATION

The State of Ohio Term Schedule requires Horton to breakout the base pricing and option pricing as submitted to the State of Ohio. Any required features that were not quoted to the State need to be separated out of the proposal and itemized. The result of this is that two separate purchase orders need to be issued for the purchase of the vehicle. They are as follows:

Purchase Order #1: Overall price total as quoted to the State of Ohio under the STS program

Purchase Order #2: Itemized price total for options and features not quoted to the State of Ohio under the STS program
