

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF PUBLIC SIDEWALKS ON BRECKSVILLE ROAD BETWEEN WHEATLEY ROAD AND 3027 BRECKSVILLE ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has prepared plans and specifications for the improvement of public sidewalks on the east side of Brecksville Road starting north of 3027 Brecksville Road continuing north to the "Richfield Commons Plaza," with additional sidewalk installation on the east side of Brecksville Road to improve crosswalk access at the intersection with Highlander Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the improvement of these sidewalks is part of the Brecksville Road/Highlander Parkway Sidewalk Plan; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Service Director to advertise for bids for the improvement of these sidewalks based upon the plans and specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Service Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the improvement of public sidewalks in furtherance of the Brecksville Road/Highlander Parkway Sidewalk Plan as described hereinabove, in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file in his office.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to proceed with public sidewalk construction at the earliest possible time in order to increase pedestrian safety as soon as possible; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
