

RESOLUTION NO. 34-2007

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT A NECESSITY TO INSTALL SEWER LINES IN THE VICINITY OF MOTOR ROAD, KNOWN AS EVERETT ROAD SEWER PHASE II, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR FUNDING FOR THE EVERETT ROAD SEWER PHASE II PROJECT IN THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, AND COMMITTING TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE LOCAL SHARE FOR SUCH PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Administration and Council of the Village of Richfield have determined it is the interest of the public to install sanitary sewer lines in the vicinity of Motor Road, known as the Everett Road Sewer Phase II; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) has funding available for public infrastructure improvements;

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield has determined it necessary to seek funding from the OPWC for the improvement of the Motor Road area in the Village by constructing sanitary sewer lines and related improvements and all other necessary appurtenances thereto; and

WHEREAS, 50% of the total cost of the Everett Road Sewer Phase II Project will be specially assessed against the properties bounding and abutting such improvement, and in anticipation of the levy and collection thereof, the City intends to issue its general obligation bond anticipation notes and bonds;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to seek approval from the OPWC for funding for the Everett Road Sanitary Sewer Phase II Project by the submission of an application and other related documentation and information as may be necessary.


SECTION 2. The Village hereby commits to provide funding for the local share of the Everett Road Sanitary Sewer Phase II Project (being 50% of the total cost thereof) by the levy and collection of special assessments against the properties bounding and abutting that improvement and the issuance of general obligation bond anticipation notes and bonds of the Village in anticipation of the levy and collection the those special assessments.

SECTION 3. The Clerk of the Council is directed to prepare a certified copy of this resolution for submission to the OPWC and such other parties as may be necessary to complete the grant application process.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village, and for the further reason that this resolution must be immediately effective so that the application for grant funding from the OPWC can be made and submitted in a timely manner; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
