A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE A JOINT APPLICATION WITH BATH TOWNSHIP, THE REVERE SCHOOLS AND RICHFIELD TOWNSHIP TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR AN OUTDOOR WARNING SIREN AT THE REVERE SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, Summit County has made the Village of Richfield, Richfield Township, the Revere School District and Bath Township aware of an Emergency Management Agency special operation grant; and

WHEREAS, this grant can be used to provide a warning siren at the Revere school building; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Mayor to make a joint application with Richfield Township, the Revere School District and Bath Township for an outdoor warning siren at the Revere Schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make a joint application with Bath Township, Revere Schools and Richfield Township to the Summit County Emergency Management Agency for a grant for an outdoor warning siren at the Revere Schools.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
