

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE A VERMEER BC1500 130HP CUMMINS DIESEL-TIER 4I BRUSH CHIPPER FROM VERMEER ALL ROADS THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village is a member of the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to purchase a Vermeer BC1500 130HP Cummins Diesel-Tier 4i brush chipper from Vermeer All Roads through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, Vermeer All Roads has offered the Village a \$15,000 discount for trading in the Village's 2013 Mobark M14R brush chipper.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio:


- SECTION 1. The Mayor and the Finance Director are hereby authorized and directed to purchase a Vermeer BC1500 130HP Cummins Diesel-4i brush chipper from Vermeer All Road, 2389 Medina Road, Medina, Ohio 44256, for a price not to exceed \$59,280.00 through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program.
- SECTION 2. Council declares that the 2013 Mobark M14R brush chipper is Village personal property that is no longer needed, is obsolete, and is unfit for the purpose for which it was acquired and, thus, is surplus property that may be disposed of by trade-in to Vermeer All Roads in order to secure a \$15,000 discount on the purchase price of the new brush chipper.
- SECTION 3. Because this purchase is made under the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program, Council waives the requirement for competitive bidding pursuant to Section 141.03(f) of the Richfield Codified Ordinances.
- SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to acquire the Vermeer BC1500 130HP Cummins Diesel-4i brush chipper at the earliest possible time; wherefore,

provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
