

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO THE
SUMMIT COUNTY SERVICE DEPARTMENT RESPONSE NETWORK
MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, certain Summit County Service Departments have formed the “Summit County Service Department Response Network,” (Summit County SDRN), to share resources and to assist each other in the form of personnel, equipment, materials and supplies in the event of emergencies that disrupt service department services; and

WHEREAS, it is the best interests of the Village to join the Summit County SDRN in order to ensure that critical public services are not disrupted in the event of an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the Summit County Service Department Response Network Mutual Aid Agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A”) and incorporated herein by reference.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees or subcommittees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to enter into this agreement to ensure that critical service operations are not disrupted in the event of an emergency; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


