

A RESOLUTION DECLARING VILLAGE PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DISPOSE OF SAID PROPERTY BY TRADE-IN AND TO APPLY THE TRADE-IN VALUE TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF NEW POLICE DEPARTMENT SERVICE WEAPONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village intends to purchase twenty-three (23) new service pistols for sworn Police Department personnel from Vance's Law Enforcement through the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the total purchase price for the twenty-three (23) new service weapons is \$9,833.30; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommend to Council that the Police Department property listed in "Exhibit A" is surplus property no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, and unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has advised Council that Vance's Law Enforcement has agreed to a trade-in of the surplus property and to apply the total trade-in value for \$4,600.00 toward to purchase price of the twenty-three (23) new service weapons.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. This Council finds that items of personal property of the Village, set forth in the attached "Exhibit A," are no longer needed for public use, are obsolete, or are unfit for the use for which they were acquired, and, thus are surplus property and available for disposition.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is authorized and directed to dispose of the surplus property by trade-in with Vance's Law Enforcement and to apply the trade-in value toward the purchase price of the twenty-three (23) new Police Department service weapons.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of ensuring that the Village can apply the trade-in value toward the outstanding invoice from Vance's Law Enforcement for the new service pistols; wherefore,

provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
