

RESOLUTION NO. 68-2005

Offered by All of Council

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE UNIFORM AND CLOTHING ALLOWANCE FOR 2005 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 153.12 of the Administrative Code provides that Council, on an annual basis, shall provide for the maintenance and replacement of clothing and equipment for Village employees; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended the clothing allowance for the year 2005.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the following shall be the annual allowance for clothing and uniforms for employees for the Village of Richfield:

Full-time Police and Fire	\$600.00 Annually
Part-time Police	\$300.00 Annually
Part-time Fire	\$ 50.00 Annually
Full-time Dispatcher	\$350.00 Annually
Part-time Dispatcher	\$175.00 Annually
Dog Warden	\$100.00 Annually
Service Department	\$300.00 Annually
Service Director	\$200.00 Annually
Zoning Inspector	\$200.00 Annually

A part-time police officer on probation status will be eligible to receive an initial uniform allowance not to exceed \$300.00. After successful completion of the probationary period, a part-time officer will receive a supplemental uniform allowance not to exceed \$300.00. A part-time officer will qualify for the annual uniform allowance of \$300.00 in the calendar year following his/her first year of service in the Village.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide for replacement and clothing for Village employees to carry out Village functions at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect

immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
