

RESOLUTION NO. 73-2005

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. TO PAVE EMERALD BOULEVARD, EVERGREEN, SWAN LAKE AND FOREST RIDGE DRIVE ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS

WHEREAS, the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. for the 2005 Asphalt Street Resurfacing Program has been accepted; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended that, on a unit price basis, Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. be authorized to pave Emerald Boulevard, Evergreen, Swan Lake and Forest Ridge Drive; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient funds appropriated to do this paving; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to contract with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. for the paving of Emerald Boulevard, Evergreen, Swan Lake and Forest Ridge Drive on an emergency basis without the necessity of formal bidding and advertisement pursuant to Revised Code 735.051 in the approximate amount of \$146,462.00.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason it is immediately necessary in order to have this essential Village work done during the summer construction season; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
