

**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING PREVIOUSLY ENCUMBERED FUNDS**

**WHEREAS**, in the normal course of operations during the Year 2002, this Council appropriated certain funds; and

**WHEREAS**, THE 2002 appropriations covered certain obligations which were not totally paid for in the Year 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to designate certain funds as being encumbered during the Year 2003 to cover carry-over obligations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Finance Director has recommended that these carry-over obligations be designated as encumbrances separate and apart from the Year 2003 appropriations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:



SECTION 1. That the following funds shall be shown as previously encumbered funds by the Finance Director to cover carry-over obligations from the Year 2002 to the Year 2003:

A) General Fund	\$ 8,804.00
B) Income Tax Fund	2,280.00
C) Fire Truck, etc. Fund	164,754.80
D) Capital Improvements	31,368.08
E) Sewer Operations Fund	23,240.42
F) Town Hall Renovation Fund	4,782.09
G) Construct Safety Building, etc. Fund	<u>80,545.00</u>


**Total Funds                    \$315,774.39**
