

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE APPLICATION BY THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO DISTRICT 8 OF THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FOR THE CLEAN OHIO CONSERVATION PROGRAM GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 41-2003, this Council has authorized application to District 8 of the Ohio Public Works Commission, for a Clean Ohio Conservation Program grant; and

WHEREAS, this Council, pursuant to Revised Code Section 164.22, wishes to indicate its support of the application in that the application will enhance and further the goals of environmental conservation and open space preservation as set forth in Revised Code Section 164.22.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council does hereby support the application by the Mayor and the Finance Director for financial assistance to District 8 of the Ohio Public Works Commission for a Clean Ohio Conservation Program Grant as being consistent with and enhancing the open space preservation and environmental conservation goals of Revised Code Section 164.22.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to be effective by the application deadline of May 16, 2003; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
