

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF TRINER EXCAVATING, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE 2003 DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2003, bids were received for the 2003 Drainage Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has recommended the acceptance of Triner Excavating, Inc. as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Triner Excavating, Inc. in the amount of \$219,230.00 for the 2003 Drainage Improvement Project, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide time for the drainage improvement projects to be pursued during the summer business season; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
