

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF PERRAM ELECTRIC, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE WHEATLEY ROAD/KINROSS LAKES PARKWAY TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2003, bids were received for the Wheatley Road/Kinross Lakes Parkway traffic signal; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has recommended the acceptance of Perram Electric, Inc. as the lowest and best bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Perram Electric, Inc., Alternate A \$99,166.20, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to allow the construction to proceed to provide traffic safety at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
