

A RESOLUTION INDICATING COUNCIL'S INTENT TO ESTABLISH A TAP-IN FEE FOR THE WATER LINE TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN EVERETT ROAD EASTERLY FROM BRECKSVILLE ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Village has constructed a water line in Everett Road; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to inform property owners abutting the water line that there will be a tap-in fee to be paid by property owners abutting the water line who wish to tap into the water line; and

WHEREAS, the tap-in fee for property owners on Everett Road is estimated to be \$31.88 per front foot; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that the foregoing estimated costs of the tap-in fee are reasonably related to the cost of providing water service and administrative costs associated therewith; and

WHEREAS, when the final construction costs for the Everett Road Water Line Contract is provided to Council, this Council will pass final tap-in fee legislation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. That this Council does hereby declare its intent to establish a tap-in fee for the water line constructed in Everett Road. The current estimated costs of the tap-in are \$31.88 per front foot.

SECTION 2. That the Service Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed, upon completion of the construction of the water line in Everett Road, to certify the final construction cost to this Council so that this Council may pass a final tap-in fee ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to allow residents to tie in for potable water at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
