

A RESOLUTION ADOPTED PURSUANT TO R.C. §709.03 INDICATING THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION TO 55.907 ACRES SITUATED IN THE ZAK/ALGER ROAD PROPERTIES UPON ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Revised Code §709.03, this Council is required to provide a statement to the Summit County Council of what services the municipal corporation will provide and an approximate date by which it will provide them to the territory proposed to be annexed which is 55.907 acres situated in the Zak/Alger Road properties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That immediately upon annexation, all Village services, including police, fire, service, EMS, garbage disposal, etc., will be provided to the territory proposed for annexation, being 55.907 acres situated in Zak/Alger Road properties.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Dear Ms. Gibson:

I am in receipt of the letter and Petition sent to you by Harry Tipping, attorney for agent for the Petitioners in the captioned matter. This letter is being sent to you pursuant to the requirements of Revised Code §709.03(B)(1). When the Summit County Council establishes the date for the hearing on this matter, Mr. Tipping is required to notify you of the date, time, place and hearing, which shall be not less than sixty (60) nor more than (90) days from October 15, 2003, the date that the Petition was filed with Clerk of the Summit County Council.

Pursuant to Revised Code §709.03(D), the Council of Richfield is required to adopt a resolution indicating what services the municipal corporation will provide and an approximate date by which it will provide them to the territory proposed for annexation, upon annexation. This resolution must be filed with the County Council at least twenty-one (21) days before the hearing. For your consideration, I am enclosing a copy of a proposed Resolution to be presented to Council for adoption.
